Submission Deadline: 6pm, October 25.

Submissions must reach the Burquest Jewish Community Association no later than the deadline date and time. Artists may submit by electronic application (email info@burquest.org) or may mail or deliver an application on CD to: **Burquest Jewish Community Association, 2860 Dewdney Trunk Rd., Coquitlam, BC, V3C 2H9**.

Project Synopsis: In collaboration with ArtsConnect and Leigh Square Community Arts Village, this Chanukah Menorah auction project will examine the “Celebration of Light” as practiced by those in the Jewish Faith. All works accepted will be on display at the Arts Village.

Cost: There is a submission fee of \$25.00 per submission or up to 3 for \$50.00. Please make cheque payable to Burquest Jewish Community Association or pay by cash or credit card

Exhibition dates are November 13th, 2010- January 9th, 2011. at Leigh Square Community Arts Village, Port Coquitlam, BC, Canada.

Reception, Auction & Winner Announcement: Thurs, December 2nd, 2010.

Eligibility

Artists from all communities are welcome to submit artwork that interprets the meaning of Chanukah and the menorah design.. For more information about the menorah design and the observation of Chanukah, please visit www.burquest.org. You do not have to be Jewish to participate.

General: All submissions must be original work. The following will not be considered:

- Copies of another artist’s work.
- Works made in part or whole from a kit or commercial design
- Works made from commercial moulds
- Works deemed inappropriate
- Works that cannot be displayed safely

Artwork: Successful entries must ensure that:

- The artwork is dry
- The artwork is ready to be exhibited by the submission deadline
- Submitted works are undamaged
- The artwork can pass through a standard double door
- 3D art work is stable and secure
- Artwork ready for auction and delivered to the Arts Village on Nov. 8th. Net proceeds from the auction will support educational public programs at Leigh Square Community Arts Village and the artist (60/40 split).
- Artists agree to insure work while in transit to the Arts Village.
- Artwork must be functional and non flammable.

- Artists responsible for packing and shipping/delivering the work safely to/from the Leigh Square Community Arts Village by Nov. 8, 2010 to the Attention of Arts & Culture Coordinator, 1100-2253 Leigh Square, Port Coquitlam, BC, V3C 3B8.
- Fee is paid in full at time of submission.
- Artist understands the work will not be returned but used in an auction to raise funds to be donated for charitable purposes, specifically towards educational public programs at the Arts Village. Net proceed from the auction will be split between Leigh Square Community Arts Village and the artist at 60/40. Works that are not sold can be returned to the artist. Artist is responsible for picking up or shipping back at the end of the exhibit.

NOTE: NO CRITIQUE OR COMMENT WILL BE PROVIDED. NO SUBMISSIONS OR FEES WILL BE RETURNED.
